BACKGROUND

In the third act of Shaw's "Man and Superman," the author interpolated a lengthy dream sequence involving four characters in the play who assume roles from Mozart's "Don Giovanni" in conversation with the devil. This gave Shaw an opportunity to expound on some of his deeply held, but controversial ideas on marriage and society.

Shaw was in the habit of writing extended prologues and epilogues to his plays, expanding on the ideas they presented, further defining and justifying them. Though written over 110 years ago, many of his views remain controversial.

In the 1903 premiere of the work, the dream sequence was omitted, to keep the production within reasonable length. The sequence itself was first performed - alone - in 1907. In 1950, four prominent Hollywood actors - Charles Boyer, Charles Laughton, Agnes Moorehead, and Sir Cedric Hardwicke - toured the country in a readers' theatre version of "Don Juan" as the First Drama Quartet.

Shortly after this, the Genesius Guild gave its first staging of the work. Tonight's production is the fourth in its 56 year history.
