The Big River Brass Band was co-founded in 2006 by the first director, Ed Butterfield and Jerry Miller with members coming from communities in and around the Quad Cities including Aledo, Dewitt, Geneseo, Milan, Maquoketa, Pleasant Valley, East Moline and all four of the Quad Cities. The 30-plus member ensemble performs traditional brass band music from over a century ago along with more contemporary works specifically written for brass band. The group also plays brass ensemble and brass choir music including arrangements from the Denver Brass and original compositions and arrangements by some of the members of the band.

The band has performed at a variety of venues including tonight's show at the Genesis Guild in Rock Island, Concert in the Park series in Aledo, Quad City Symphony Pops in LeClaire Park, Festival of Trees, Brass at the Barn at Playcrafters Barn Theater, Beaux Arts and the Art Stroll in Davenport, and is available to play for special occasions and other concerts.
